Zero Emission Tokyo Strategy

We are currently facing a climate crisis as the impacts of climate change have become more serious, including unprecedented heat and heavy rains.

In response to this crisis TMG had declared that Tokyo would pursue efforts to limit the global average temperature increase to 1.5°C which entails a lower risk and realize a Zero Emission Tokyo that would contribute to achieving net zero CO₂ emissions by 2050. In December 2019, we formulated the Zero Emission Tokyo Strategy. Based on the governor's "Declaration of Tokyo's Climate Crisis Action," we will work with Tokyo's citizens to stand against this climate crisis and call for their understanding and cooperation.

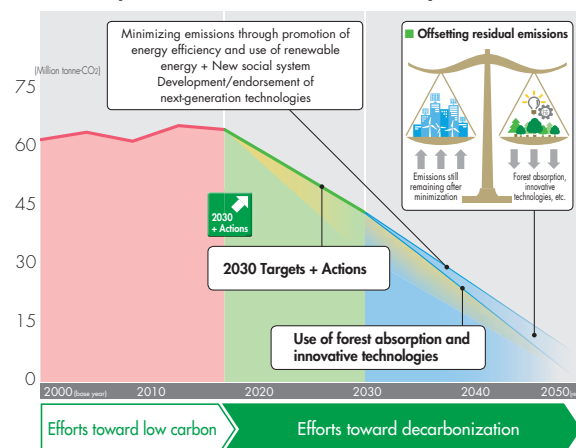
Latest Topic

On December 4, 2020, the governor, in response to the worsening climate crisis, announced Tokyo's "Climate Emergency Declaration: TIME TO ACT" in order to accelerate effective efforts and lead the world through action in cooperation with international networks, such as C40.

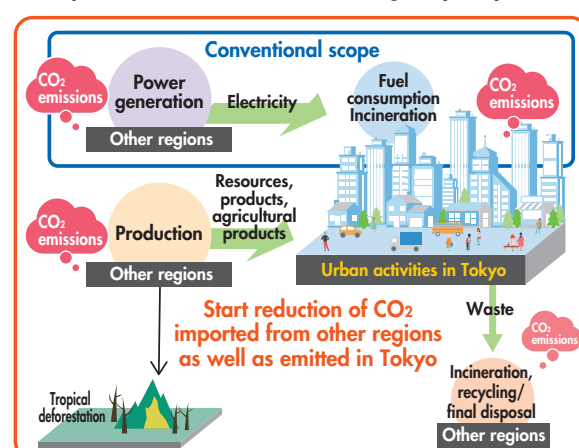
Aiming for Net Zero Emissions in Tokyo, Contributing to the Reduction of CO₂ Imported from Other Regions

Scope of emissions reductions envisaged by Tokyo

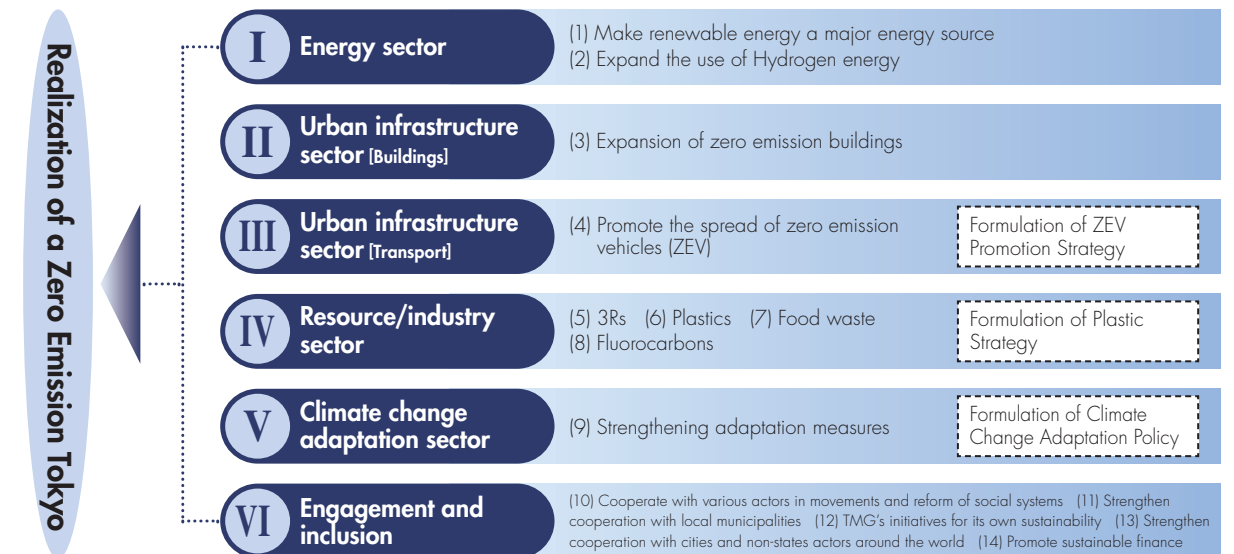


Clarifying 2050 Goals and 2030 Targets and Actions for each Prioritized Field
