













Located next to Tokyo Midtown, visitors can enjoy the beauty of nature in the center of the city.












E Swift-footed Idaten

Ogannonji Temple is located in central Nihombashi Ningyocho, Chuo Ward. Here, a statue of Idaten, a swift-footed god, is enshrined. Until recently, the statue was known to only a few. However, now, the number of visitors hoping to catch a glimpse of Idaten is growing. Those entering the Tokyo Marathon hoping to better their time may want to consider paying a visit to the shrine with fellow runners.
