## The Stars as Seen from a Cruise Ship

In a mobile planetarium, visitors experience views of the stars that can be seen only from a ship. The planetarium's dome has a six meter circumference accommodating about 30 people (40 including children). During the festival it will be set to show the May 2016 skies as seen from ship after setting off from Japan, with night views from the northern to the southern hemisphere. When the scene changes, visitors can view the skies as they will be seen when sailing in August 2016 from Florida, traveling toward the North Pole via Norway. This pleasant 15-minute show is set to music and will be repeated about 10 times each day.
