

4. What is a concession scheme/type (as defined in Japan under the Act on Promotion of Private Finance Initiatives (Act No. 117 of 1999))

This scheme allows the public body to grant concession rights to private operators for them to operate facilities (public assets) where service fees are collected from the users, while asset ownership remains with the public authority. The scheme can apply to both the existing and newly built facilities.

The concession rights are intended to allow the private operators to operate the facilities flexibly (including the right to set user fees with the condition of prior notification to the public body) and expected to make use of their creativity and ingenuity.

Moreover, flexible financing are expected by morgaging concession rights and other means.
