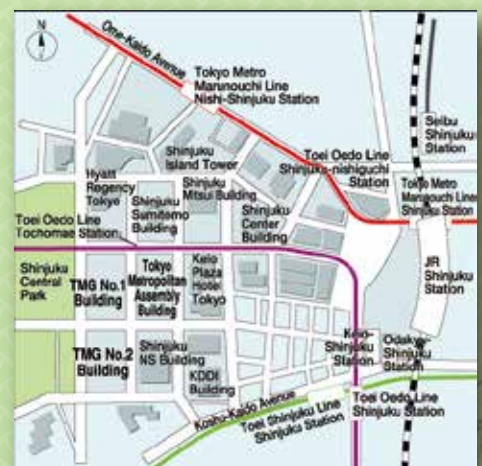

Access

Nearest stations to TMG Buildings

- "JR Shinjuku Station" (10-minute walk from the West Exit).
- "Tochomae Station" on the Toei Oedo Subway Line.
- Take the Toei Bus or Keio Bus (Tocho Junkan) from "Shinjukueki Nishiguchi" bus stop at the West Exit of JR Shinjuku Station (underground bus terminal) and get off at "Tocho Daiichi Honchoshu" (TMG No. 1 Building), "Tocho Daini Honchoshu" (TMG No. 2 Building) or "Togikai Gijido" (Tokyo Metropolitan Assembly Building).
- Take the Shinjuku WE Bus bound for "Nishi Shinjuku Tocho Honchoshu" from the "Shinjukueki Nishiguchi" bus stop at the West Exit of JR Shinjuku Station and get off at "Tocho Honchoshu" (TMG).
